### **ABOUT THE COLLEGE**

Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalaya was established at Amjonga in the district of Goalpara by the Government of Assam with the financial assistance from the Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA). The institution was named after Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya, a great thinker, philosopher and a renowned sociologist of the country. The government initiative to establish the college was to provide quality higher education compatible to one available in the best institutes of the country along with a distinct focus on science education, which is affordable and accessible to all sections of the society. The foundation of the college was laid on 29th October, 2014 and through continuous efforts of the Department of Higher Education and the RUSA, the institution has finally been able to open the gate for the first batch of students from the academic year 2017-18.

The college is located at Amjonga, a very beautiful and mesmerising tiny hamlet, about 7 km from Dudhnoi, the headquarter of Rabha Hasong Autonomous Council in Goalpara district. The college has an infrastructure built on a sprawling campus spreading over 25 bighas of land. The serene and the green campus of the college has the best ambiance including well-stocked library, digital classrooms, up to date laboratories conductive for teaching, learning and research along with residential facilities for college staff and girl students. Although the infrastructure of the college is yet to be completed, it is hoped that it will be completed soon by the sincere efforts of the concerned authorities. Agalaxy of highly qualified and dedicated faculties put their best efforts to impart education by monitoring the students for their overall improvements. At present, the college offers Higher Secondary course in Science stream under Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) and an undergraduate programme leading to Bachelors' Degree in Science (B.Sc.) under the Gauhati University. The college has an ambitious plan to introduce Post Graduate courses along with several Skill Development courses in the years to come.

#### ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. Higher Secondary (Science)/ B. Sc. 1st Semester admission for new Academic Year, 2022-2023 will be started immediately after the declaration of HSLC/HS result.
- 2. Application Form for admission into the college will be available in the office of the Principal issued by the college office on payment of Rs 300/- (Rupees Three Hundred only).
- 3. Admission into the college is made strictly in order of merit and is governed by the college admission rules. The Principal's decision regarding admission is final.
- 4. A student can opt for only those subjects in TDC in which he/she has passed in H.S. without grace marks.
- 5. A candidate must produce the following documents in original at the time of admission.
  - (a) Mark Sheet and Admit Card of the last qualifying examination.
  - (b) Age Certificate/ HSLC Admit Card.
  - (c) Character Certificate from the head of the Institution last attended.
  - (d) Two copies of recent passport size photograph.
  - (e) Caste Certificate from competent authority (wherever applicable).
  - (f) Certificate for differently abled (wherever applicable).
  - (g) Certificate/Documents for co-curricular activities (only state and national level certificate will be entertained).
  - (h) Gap Certificate (wherever applicable)
- 6. All candidates must submit self-attested copies of (a), (b), (c) from the above at the time of application. Students belonging to SC, ST(P), ST (H), OBC and MOBC categories must also submit an attested copy of (e) in addition to (a), (b) and (c). Students who want to avail (f), (g) and (h) must furnish suitable documents at the time of application.
- 7. Incomplete form or form without documents will be rejected.
- 8. No form will be accepted after the last date of submission under any circumstances.

#### N.B. Gap Certificate must be issued from any one of the following:

- (a) Head of the Institution last attended.
- (b) Officer in-charge of the nearest police station.
- (c) Government Gazetted officer testifying his/her activities during the intern period.
- (d) Medical Certificate from govt. registered Medical practitioner on genuine medical grounds.

#### ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR H.S. 1ST YEAR (SCIENCE):

HSLC with minimum 50% of marks for General Category/ 45% of marks for SC/ST Category/ 47% of marks for OBC/MOBC Category.

- a. English
- b. MIL Assamese or Alternative English or Bodo (self study)
- c. Environmental Studies (in first year only)

#### **Elective Subjects:**

**Note**: As per AHSEC regulation, a student opting Computer Science as an elective subject in Science stream shall have to opt Mathematics and two other elective subjects. i.e. such a student shall have four elective subjects.

#### **ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR TDC 1ST YEAR (SCIENCE):**

- 1. HS (Science) Final Examination Passed with minimum 50% of marks for General Category/ 45% of marks for SC/ST Category/ 47% of marks for OBC/MOBC Category.
- 2. An applicant has to select his/her combination of subjects as the following table. He/she should passed in the concerned subject in 10+2 as mentioned below:

# SCHEME FOR WAIVER OF ADMISSION FEE FOR STUDENTS TAKING ADMISSION IN HS 1st YEAR AND TDC 1st YEAR

As per the order of the Government of Assam, the college has decided to waive the fees, including admission and tuition fees for HS 1st year and TDC 1st year College Students belonging to economically backward families whose parent's annual income is less than Rs 1 lakh. To avail the scheme, the parental income of the student be less than Rs 1 lakh from all the sources. If either of the parents (mother or father) of the student is working in the State Govt/ Central Govt/ Semi Govt/ State or Central Govt undertakings, such students shall not be eligible under this scheme.

#### PROOF OF INCOME/ DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- (a) An Income Certificate from the local Revenue Circle Officer or Mauzadar.
- (b) A declaration from the students that neither of the parent (father or mother) of the student is an employee of State/Central Govt. Department or its undertaking.

#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF STUDENTS AVAILING THE SCHEME:**

Students seeking admission into 1st year will plant a sapling at his/her College or at his/ her home and shall submit photograph of the same to the college. The student has to nurse the sapling and while seeking admission into second year shall submit photograph of the same tree that was planted during previous year.

#### **EXAMINATION AND ATTENDANCE RULES:**

- It is compulsory for the students to appear in all the examinations conducted by the College during per academic sessions.
- For HS students, the college conducts Unit Tests in the middle of the session and Test examinations after completion of the entire syllabus.
- For B.Sc. students, there are two Sessional Examinations per year, one for each semester. It is mandatory to appear in the Sessional Examinations without fail as the marks secured will be added in the Final Examination.
- Students must attend their classes regularly. At least 75% attendance in class is compulsory
  failing to which the student will be declared as Non-Collegiate. Less than 60% attendance will be
  declared as Dis-Collegiate. Non-Collegiate students may be allowed to appear in Final
  Examinations with a stipulated fine to the college whereas Dis-Collegiate students cannot appear
  in Final Examinations.

#### **INFRA-STRUCTURAL FACILITIES:**

#### Central Library :

The Central Library of the college contains a spacious reading hall for teachers and students. Till now, more than 7,000 textbooks and reference books of different subjects are available. In due course, more books will be purchased.

#### Laboratory Facilities:

Each department of the college has well-furnished and well-equipped laboratories and being upgraded day by day for the benefit of the students.

#### • Smart Classrooms:

At present there are four smart classrooms in the college which provide advanced teaching-learning process and mechanisms.

#### • Hostel Facilities:

There is a girls' hostel in the college campus with the capacity of 68 students.

#### • Sports and Gymnasium:

The college contains various sports equipments like cricket, football, volleyball, badminton, table tennis etc. The well-equipped gymnasium of the college is set up for the benefit of the students.

#### • Boys' and Girls' Common Rooms:

The college provides separate Boys' and Girls' common rooms with necessary amenities.

#### • Health Centre:

There is a health centre available in the college campus for emergency.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP:**

Students of the college can avail various scholarships on fulfilling the eligibility norms. Some of them are

- a. National Scholarship.
- b. State Merit Scholarship.
- c. Post Matric Scholarship (for students belonging to ST, SC, OBC and MOBC categories).
- d. Scholarship for Minority students.

#### **ACADEMIC AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:**

#### Excursion and Field Trip

The various departments of the college organise regular excursions and field trips for the students to gain firsthand experience and collect data in the concerned subjects both in HS and TDC courses.

#### • Remedial Classes

Different departments of the college have provisions of remedial classes and tutorial classes for the weak students based on their performance in unit tests and sessional examinations.

#### Annual College Week

In order to encourage all-round development of the students, the Annual College Week is organised every year by the college where students get exposure to excel in sports, cultural and other co-curricular activities

#### GENERAL RULES FOR STUDENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT:

Great emphasis is laid on discipline and character building of student and they are expected to maintain a high standard of discipline. They are subject to the rules and regulations of the College and Hostels. Students must carry their Identity cards and produce when necessary. The college authority should be intimidated in case of loss or damage of the Identity Cards. Moreover, involvement in the followings will be punishable if found guilty:

- a. Violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, irregular clearance of college and hostel fee.
  - b. Discourtesy to the teachers and staff members in any form.
  - c. Adoption of unfair means during examination.
  - d. The college campus is strictly a "No Smoking"/ "No Alcohol" zone.
  - e. Mobile phones and other electronic gadgets are prohibited inside the classrooms.
  - f. Ragging in any form will lead to punishment of the students indulged in by the college authority, as per the directives of the Supreme Court.
  - g. Damage of college property, spitting, writing and sticking bills on the college walls will be punishable.
  - h. Any form of sexual harassment should be reported to the college authority in written in the 'Sexual Harassment Complaint Box'.
  - i. Student Societies and Associations shall be subject to such rules and regulations as the college authority may prescribe from time to time. Only those Societies and Associations recognized by the college authority shall have the facilities of the College premises.

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO PARENTS/ GUARDIANS:**

- a. Parents/ Guardians should kindly cooperate with the college authority to ensure the better performance of the students.
- b. Parents/ Guardians are requested to attend the Parents' Meets or any other college functions/programmes organised by the college authority.
- c. Parents/Guardians are requested to monitor the progress of the students at home and provide adequate facilities for study.

#### REGULATIONS OF TDC FOR SEMESTER SYSTEM (GAUHATI UNIVERSITY):

- 1. A TDC shall be of Six Semesters covering three Calendar Years. The schedule for Semester system shall be as shown below:
  - a. First, Third and Fifth Semester (including examinations): August 1- Dec 31
  - b. Second, Fourth and Sixth Semester (including examinations): January 1- June 30
  - c. Semester Break: July 10-July 31

2. Students' performance should be monitored throughout the Semester by continuous assessments in the theory and practical courses. Evaluation of the Students' performance in each of the theory and practical paper will be based on the following:

Internal Evaluation: 20% Marks External Evaluation: 80% Marks

- 3. Internal Evaluation should be based on sessional examinations, home assignments, seminars and library works in each Semester.
- 4. External Evaluation should be through a final examination at the end of the Semester.
- 5. The pass marks in each theory paper is 30% and that in each practical paper is 40%.
- 6. In each paper, students must secure pass marks in both the internal as well as the external evaluation separately.
- 7. A student who could not appear or failed in any semester examination will be allowed to clear the same as follows:
  - a. First semester with the regular Third semester examination.
  - b. Second semester with the regular Fourth semester examination.
  - c. Third semester with the regular Fifth semester examination.
  - d. Fourth semester with the regular Sixth semester examination.
- 8. A student may be allowed to 'Repeat' any one of the theory papers in the First, Second, Third and Fourth Semester, and may be allowed for 'Betterment' of marks in one paper in the Fifth Semester, provided the student secures less than 45% marks in that paper.
- 9. No 'Repeat'/ 'Betterment' shall be allowed in the practical examinations in any Semester.
- 10. A student must pass all his Semester examinations, including 'Repeat' and 'Betterment' chances within five years from the date of admission to the First Semester course. A student will get a maximum of three chances to clear a particular Semester.
- 11. In case of any dispute regarding evaluation or unforeseen events the matter may be placed in the Committee of Courses and Studies (U.G.) for amicable settlement.
- 12. Since the Semester involves continuous assessment there would be no scope for a student to appear as a private candidate in any subject.
- 13. For any matter not covered under this Regulation for Semester system, the existing University Rules and the Gauhati University Act 1949 (as amended till date) should be applicable.

#### **COLLEGE UNIFORM:**

Trouser: Formal-White (Low Waist Jeans and Trousers are not allowed)

Shirt : Formal-Purple and White Checks (Short shirts with different collars are not allowed)

Girls:
